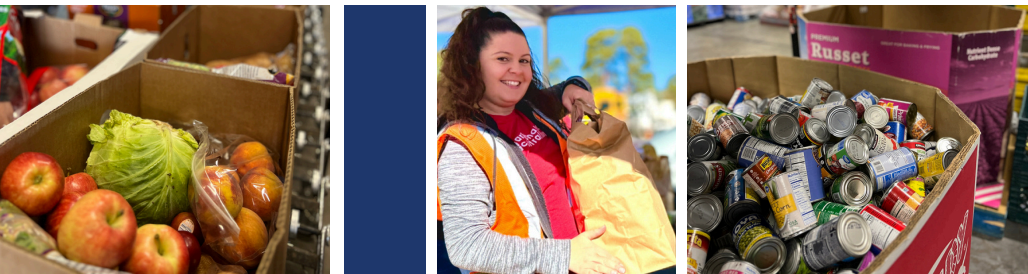

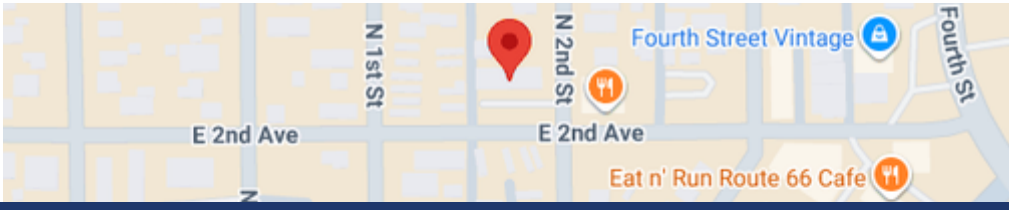

## Food Dates Explained

**Food safety and your health are important to us.**

While we do our best to sort through food, it's important for you to examine it yourself before eating or serving it to your family. \*Avoid eating food that shows signs of mold, has unpleasant odors, unusual colors, damaged packaging, leaks, rust, or any other signs of spoilage. Use your sight, smell, and touch to check food before eating.

Many foods have dates on the package, but most of these dates are about **quality, not safety**. “Sell By,” “Best By,” “Best If Used By,” and “Enjoy By” dates mean the food may still be safe to eat after those dates if it looks and smells okay.

**Only true expiration dates—such as those on baby food or infant formula—mean the food is not safe after that date.**

*\*Not all bacteria and pathogens that cause foodborne illnesses show visible signs of contamination. This is not a comprehensive list and should only be used as general guidelines for evaluating the safety of donated foods.*

## Food Bank Information

### Government Programs & Your Right to Privacy

We provide free, federally funded food assistance that requires basic identification to distribute USDA foods. Your personal information is kept secure, not shared, and only used in anonymous reports.

**Those who choose not to provide identification will still receive food.**

If you want to pick up food for someone who can't make it to one of our food distributions, have them fill out YOUR information on the "Authorization for Proxy" portion of the "Application for Benefits" form, available at [hotfood.org/find-food](https://hotfood.org/find-food)
